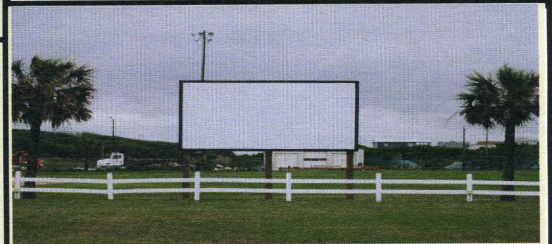
Business Entrance Contest
